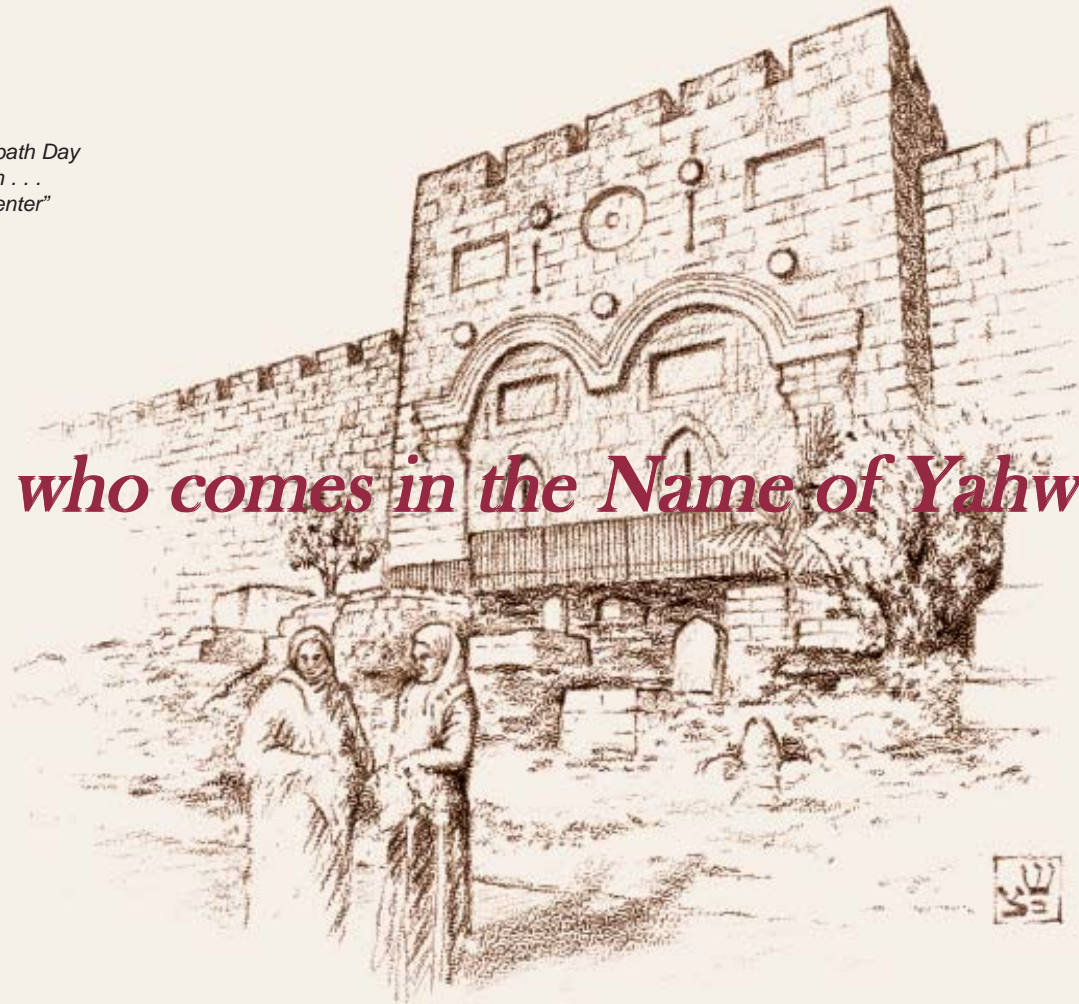

It requires preparation before the end of the sixth day. This ancient understanding has prophetic significance seen in Revelation.






